WEDNESDAY, MARCH 17, 2021 – MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE FIRST PLANNING DISTRICT WDB EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE, HELD AT 8:30am, VIA Zoom meeting platform. This meeting was held virtually due to the COVID 19 crisis.

<u>In attendance</u>: Alan Thriffiley, Mike Stedem, Steve Price, Stephanie Dupepe, Jerry Repka, Jennifer Barnett and Melissa Kirsch.

The meeting was called to order at 8:30am.

- 1. Chairman Thriffiley called the meeting to order and asked Ms. Kirsch to report out on the expenditures and Fund Utilization reports through January 2021. Ms. Kirsch reviewed the documents and indicated that spending of formula dollars was going very well although Plaquemines and St. Bernard were somewhat behind in participant spending. She also indicated that the Centers were on track to spend old Youth funds that would be at-risk of recapture, however, there was still a lot of work to be done in getting caught up on youth spending overall. Covid certainly caused a significant slow-down in the planned youth activities. She also gave a brief update on the progress of expenditures under the Disaster grant.
- 2. The next item on the agenda was an update and discussion on issues pertaining to the Disaster Dislocated Worker Grant. Ms. Kirsch explained to the members certain challenges related to having the temporary jobs participants as employees of the First Planning District. Because we are an extension of the St. Bernard Parish Government, these individuals may be able to file unemployment claims against the parish and FPD would not be allowed to cover those costs after the grant ends. Discussion ensued. Ms. Kirsch also stated that LWC had contracted with a third party (CSRS) to serve as the employer of record so that local boards would not have this issue. The local area could enter into an MOU with CSRS, thereby allowing us to utilize them as the employer of record and remove liability from St. Bernard Parish Government. After further discussion, the Executive Committee felt it was the only option to pursue and asked Ms. Kirsch to invite a CSRS representative to give a brief presentation to the full board.
- 3. At this time, Ms. Kirsch gave an update on the process for hiring a Director of Planning and Operations. She stated that she did interview three good candidates, one of which was Ms. Barnett, the current One-Stop Operator. Chairman Thriffiley conducted second interviews with all three candidates and the position was offered and excepted by Ms. Barnett. Ms. Kirsch indicated that she would put a plan together to share with the Executive Committee at the next meeting outlining the transition of Ms. Barnett to her new position. Chairman Thriffiley also reminded Ms. Kirsch that the salary range for this position would have to go before the Board for approval.

- 4. Ms. Kirsch gave the following updates:
 - •Center leadership was in the process of making decisions on the reopening of the Centers to the general public, but they should be fully opened within the next four to six weeks
 - •Discussions were underway in both St. Tammany and St. Bernard regarding possible summer youth programs.
 - •The Community Development Committee was researching a new virtual referral platform (Unite Louisiana) that may provide great benefits in ensuring increased partnership engagement across agencies
 - •Invited LCTCS to give a presentation at the upcoming Board meeting regarding their "Reboot Your Career" initiative. The Tri-Parish Works Centers are working closely with this project to leverage WIOA resources to ensure successful outcomes
- 5. Under Other Business, Ms. Kirsch reminded the members of the Personal Financial Disclosures being due to the Ethics Commission no later than May 15th. She intended to remind all board members at the upcoming meeting as well as sending out email reminders.

Chairman Thriffiley commented on how he continues to be impressed with our local leadership and staff and feels they are extremely dedicated and knowledgeable.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 9:50am.
